Montana Wins National Championship

Montana received an outstanding effort from its defense and used an efficient offense to win the I-AA National Championship with a 13-6 victory over Furman.

The win gave Montana its second title in school history after winning the championship in 1995 as well. For the Grizzlies it was their fourth appearance in the championship game in the last seven years. The win also avenged a 27-25 loss to Georgia Southern in the 2000 title game.

Montana finished the year 15-1, setting a new school record for wins in a season. UM also closed out the year with 14 straight wins.

Grizzly running back Yo Humphery had 142 yards and one touchdown on 30 carries against Furman. Quarterback John Edwards was 18-of-28 passing for 124 yards and added 32 yards rushing. Playing in his last game for Montana wide receiver Etu Molden caught 10 passes for 74 yards.

Montana scored first on a two-yard run by Humphery in the second quarter and added a Chris Snyder 35-yard field goal to lead 10-0 at halftime. The Grizzlies would then get a 30-yard field goal from Snyder to lead 13-0 with 6:12 remaining in the game.

Furman avoided a shutout when James Thomas caught a 54-yard hail-mary touchdown pass on the final play of the game. The play kept Montana from pitching a shutout, which would have been the second in a row for UM after a 38-0 semifinal win over Northern Iowa. Furman standout running back Louis Ivory was held to just 33 yards on 12 carries in the game and quarterback Billy Napier was picked off twice.

Big Sky Plays In Fifth Title Game In Eight Years: When Montana played Furman in the 2001 National Championship game, it marked the fifth time in the past eight years that the Big Sky has been represented in the title game. Montana also played in the championship game in 2000, 1996 and 1995. Boise State represented the Big Sky in 1994 when the Broncos lost to Youngstown State in the finals. The 2001 title game marked the ninth time in history that a Big Sky team has played for the championship. Also playing in the title game as a member of the Big Sky were Nevada (1990), Montana State (1984), Idaho State (1981) and Boise State (1980). The Big Sky is now 5-4 in title games.

Big Sky Adds Fifth National Title: The Big Sky Conference notched its fifth national title team when Montana defeated Furman for the 2001 National Championship. The win by the Grizzlies gives the Big Sky a winning record in nine title game appearances, now 5-4. The last title team from the conference was Montana in 1995. The Grizzlies defeated Marshall 22-20 in the championship. Montana State defeated Louisiana Tech 19-6 for the title in 1984. The Big Sky had back-to-back champs in 1980 and 1981. Boise State won the championship over Eastern Kentucky 31-29 in 1980 and Idaho State beat Eastern Kentucky 34-23 in 1981 to win the title.

Chatman, Huntsberger, Fuqua Earn League Honors: The Big Sky Conference announced its end of the season award winners. Eastern Washington running back Jesse Chatman was named the Offensive Player of the Year while Vince Huntsberger, a safety from Montana, was named the conference's Defensive Player of the Year and Portland State freshman running back Ryan Fuqua was named Newcomer of the Year. Chatman finished the year with 2,096 rushing yards and 24 touchdowns for the Eagles. His rushing total is the second-best single-season performance in Big Sky history, behind Charles Roberts' 2,260 yards in 1998. Chatman also scored 172 points this season, breaking the previous Big Sky record of 170 set by Geoff Mitchell of Weber State in 1991, and piled up 2,520 all-purpose yards, breaking the conference record of 2,432 set by Archie Amerson of Northern Arizona in 1996. Chatman averaged 190.5 rushing yards a game to lead the country in 2001. Chatman was a second team selection in 2000. Huntsberger finished the year with 110 total tackles this season for Montana and led the conference in fumbles forced with five. This is the second time Huntsberger has been named Defensive Player of the Year having also earned the honor following the 1999 season. Fuqua ended the season with 1,586 yards rushing, 909 of which came in the last three games of the year. Fuqua, a redshirt freshman, rushed for 393, 270 and 243 yards in his last three games, setting a new I-AA three-game rushing record. Fuqua averaged 144.2 yards a game in 2001, good for fifth in the country.

Glenn, Wulff Earn Co-Coach of the Year Honor: Montana head coach Joe Glenn and Eastern Washington head coach Paul Wulff were named Big Sky Conference Co-Coaches of the Year as selected by the league's eight head coaches. Glenn led his team to a perfect 7-0 mark in the Big Sky this season and is undefeated in league play in two years with a 15-0 record. Overall Glenn is 27-3 at Montana. This is the second year in a row Glenn has been named Coach of Year after earning the honor following the 2000 season as well. Wulff led Eastern Washington to a 7-4 record in his second year with the Eagles. The Eagles led the country in rushing offense (225.4 ypg), total offense (514.5 ypg) and scoring offense (41.9 ppg). Wulff is 13-9 in two years at EWU and is 8-7 in Big Sky games.

Montana Wins 2001 Big Sky Football Title: Montana clinched the 2001 Big Sky football championship with a 38-23 win over Weber State in Missoula on Nov. 10. It is the fourth straight Big Sky title for the Grizzlies and their seventh in the last nine years. It is the 10th title for UM in school history. With the title Montana automatically advanced to the I-AA playoffs. Montana has now won 20 Big Sky Conference games in a row and 17 straight home games overall. The Grizzlies have also won 11 road conference games in a row after their 38-27 win at Montana State. The 20 straight conference wins and 11 straight road conference wins are both Big Sky records.
