The Griz Coaching Staff

Jerry Wagner: In just four seasons Montana coach Jerry Wagner has turned the Grizzlies volleyball program into a Big Sky Conference championship contender. After a five-year absence from postseason play, Wagner has guided the program to three of the last four Big Sky Conference tournaments. By leading the team to back-to-back 10-6 league marks, Wagner and the Grizzlies have won double-figure Big Sky Conference matches for the first time since the early 90s. Individual recognition has been a byproduct of the team's success. This past fall, junior middle blocker Jaimie Thibeault was named first team All-Big Sky for the second straight season, and junior Brittney Brown was named Libero of the Year. Senior setter Taryn Wright was a second-team selection, and Montana added a pair of honorable mention picks. Wagner's NCAA Division I coaching experience dates back to 1988 when he was hired to be an assistant under legendary Griz coach Dick Scott. In three seasons together, Scott and Wagner led Montana to a pair of 20-win seasons and the 1990 NCAA tournament, the program's first. **Kandice Kelly (Camp Director):** Kelly finished her 3rd season as an assistant coach. Kelly is a 2007 graduate of Montana State, where she was a four-year member (2003-06) of the Bobcats. She is the MSU single-season (495) and career (1,720) leader in digs. The 2002 Montana Gatorade Girls' Volleyball Player of the Year, Kelly led Roundup High School to four Class B state titles while starring for the Panthers as a setter and outside hitter for her mother, Laurie Kelly, who is now the head coach at Rocky Mountain College.

Gina Schmidt: The Grizzlies' 4th place finish in 2009 marked Gina Schmidt's second year as an assistant coach with the Montana volleyball program. It is also the second year of collegiate coaching for Schmidt, who recently concluded a six-year professional playing career as a setter and outside hitter in Europe and with the Canadian National Team. Schmidt, originally from Beaverlodge, Alberta, was a four-year letter-winner at Oregon State (1998-2001) and was an All-Pac-10 selection as a junior in 2000.
