Directions for obtaining game day admissions:

- Go to the Player Guest Pass Room. The room is located in the concourse between the east side of the Adams Center and the west side of the stadium.
- The room opens 3 hours before kickoff.
- NCAA rules require that you show picture ID. **You will not be able to get your ticket without ID.**
- After showing picture ID at the entrance counter, you will then move in line to the ticket table, where you will sign for your ticket.
- The attendant will stub your ticket and stamp your hand. You need both the stub and hand stamp in order to enter the gates. Gates open 1 ½ hours before kickoff.
- Once you have your ticket stub and hand stamp, you are free to do other activities until you are ready to enter the game. You can enter at any gate.
- Tickets are not pre-assigned. Tickets are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Every person must be present to show ID and sign for his/her own ticket. If your entire party is not together at the same time, you can receive your ticket and request that the other tickets be set aside so your entire party can sit together. Please make sure that the others in your party know to ask for those set-aside tickets when they come through the room.
- Your name must be on the list in order to receive a ticket (players, coaches, spirit squad members designate guest names via an online ticket system). If it is not, you are welcome to purchase a ticket. NCAA rules prohibit us from being able to distribute complimentary tickets to those not on the list. Doing so could result in an ineligibility status for the affected player.
