Montana On the Road For Big Sky Games at UNC & at NAU, Thursday & Saturday, Jan. 28th & 30th

THE GAME: The University of Montana Grizzlies (13-7/4-4 Big Sky) continue their Big Sky Conference schedule on the road, playing the 10th-ranked (Mid-Major Poll) **Northern Colorado Bears** (17-4/6-2) and the **Northern Arizona Lumberjacks** (10-9/4-4) on Thursday, Jan. 28 and Saturday, Jan. 30.

TIP-OFFS: Tip-off in UNC's Butler-Hancock Sports Pavilion (2,977) is at 7:05 p.m., while the game in NAU's J. Lawrence Walkup Skydome (7,000) begins at 6:35 p.m.

GRIZ RECENT GAME(S): At Montana State 61, Montana 52: UM trailed by as many as 11 points in the second half, but when center **Brian Qvale** dunked with 2:33 left, the score was 51-50, Cats. But, MSU out-scored the Grizzlies 11-1 after that to pull out the victory. **Qvale** led Montana with 18 points. Forward **Jack McGillis** added 12 points and 7 rebounds. Griz guard **Anthony Johnson** was held to 8 points, but grabbed a career-high 8 rebounds. MSU led 28-21 at halftime.

EARLIER THIS SEASON: At Montana 71, NAU 54: **Johnson** scored 22 points to lead the Grizzlies in the early (Dec. 4) league opener for the teams. *Shane Johannsen* led NAU with 16 points. **Northern Colorado 59, at Montana 48:** Guard *Yahosh Bonner* scored 19 points and was 10-of-10 from the line to lead the Bears, who made 25-of-30 (83.3%) free throws (UM made 11 of 16 FTs) in the win. **Johnson** was held to 7 points. **Qvale** led UM with 16 points and 11 rebounds. UNC took an early 12-10 lead on a three-pointer by *Bonner* and did not trail the rest of the game. (*Box scores from both games are in this release.*)

MONTANA HEAD COACH
WAYNE TINKLE
(61-50, Fourth Season at UM)



Wayne Tinkle has an overall record of 61-50 (.541) and is 33-23 (.589) in the Big Sky. He is ranked eighth in school history with his 61 victories.

Tinkle, 41, was named the 26th head coach at Montana in the summer of 2006, replacing Larry Krystkowiak, who left UM to become the head coach of the Milwaukee Bucks. He served as an assistant coach at UM for the previous five seasons, working with Krystkowiak for two seasons, two years with Pat Kennedy (2002-04), and one with Don Holst (2001-02).

In his inaugural season (2006-07) as head coach at his alma mater, Coach Tinkle guided Montana to a 17-15 overall record and a third-place finish in league with a 10-6 mark.

Tinkle was a standout forward for the Griz from 1985-89 and a three-time All-Big Sky pick his sophomore, junior and senior seasons. He is ranked fourth in career rebounds with 836 and sixth in career points with 1,500. He is also ranked among the Big Sky's career leaders in both of those two categories.

He was Montana's *Carl Dragstedt Award* (MVP) winner in 1988 and 1989. He led the team in rebounding in 1987 (8.9 average), 1988 (8.4 average), and 1989 (8.7 avg.), and in scoring in 1988 (16.2 ppg) and 1989 (17.1 ppg).

He played in the professional ranks for 12 seasons, from 1990 to 2001. He played in the Continental Basketball League in Topeka, Kansas, and finished the year playing in Venezuela. In his professional career he played in the CBA and in Sweden, Spain, Italy and Greece. He played his final four seasons in Spain from 1995-99, where he ranked among the league's top scorers and rebounders.

Wayne was born in Milwaukee, Wis., and is the youngest of 11 children (seven girls and four boys). He is a 1984 graduate of Ferris High School in Spokane, Wash. He received his degree in health and human performance from UM in 2005. He married former Lady Griz basketball star Lisa McLeod. Wayne and Lisa have three children: daughters Joslyn and Elleson, and son Tres. Joslyn currently plays basketball at Stanford University.
