RADIO/TV: UM's flagship station is KVWE Radio (101.5 FM) with **Mick Holien**, the "Voice of the Grizzlies," calling the play-by-play and **Greg Sundberg** providing color. The UM-NAU game will be not be televised.

"AJ" NAMED 1ST TEAM ALL-LEAGUE

For the second year in a row **Johnson**, a 6-3 senior guard from Tacoma, Wash. was a unanimous pick to the Big Sky's all-league first team. Last season **Johnson** was named to the first team and was also tabbed the Big Sky's "Top Newcomer."

Montana's **Will Cherry**, a freshman guard from Oakland, Calif., and **Ryan Staudacher**, a senior guard from Kirkland, Wash., were named to the Big Sky's 2010 honorable mention team.

THE GAME: The fourth-seed **University of Montana Grizzlies** (19-9/10-6 Big Sky) host the fifth-seed **Northern Arizona Lumberjacks** (14-13/8-8 BSC) in a Big Sky Conference Tournament quarterfinal game, Saturday, March 6th. Tip-off in UM's Adams Center/Dahlberg Arena (7,321) is at 7:05 p.m. (Mountain). The other quarterfinal game pits sixth-seed Portland State (12-18/7-9 BSC) at third-seed Montana State (15-13/10-6 BSC).

BIG SKY TOURNEY: If Montana wins Saturday it will advance to a Big Sky semifinal contest, playing either number one seed and host Weber State (19-9/13-3 BSC) or second-seed Northern Colorado (24-6/12-4), Tuesday, March 9. WSU plays the highest remaining seed at 7:00 p.m., while UNC will play the highest remaining seed at 4:30 p.m. Both games will be played in WSU's Dee Events Center (12,000) and aired on *Altitude TV*. WSU plays the lowest remaining seed, while UNC plays the highest seed left. The tournament championship game is Wednesday, March 9th at 7:00 p.m. and will be televised on *ESPN2*.

GRIZ IN BSC TOURNEY: This is Montana's 31st league postseason tournament berth -- the second most in Big Sky history (host WSU is making its 33rd appearance). UM has missed the postseason tourney only twice (1999 and 2001). The Grizzlies have a record of 25-24 in the tourney and have won six championships. (*UM tourney history on add 6-6-6*).

UM vs. NAU: The Grizzlies are 4-1 against the Jacks in the Big Sky's postseason tourney: **1984:** @UM 69, NAU 54 (1st Round) **2006:** UM 73, @NAU 60 (Championship) **1988:** UM 77, NAU 72 (1st Rnd. in Bozeman) **2007:** NAU 78, UM 71 (Semi in Ogden) **2002:** UM 82, NAU 64 (Q-Final in Bozeman)

GRIZ LAST WEEK: **Montana State 73, at Montana 67:** *Will Bynum* scored 22 points, and MSU had four double-figure scorers as MSU swept UM during the regular-season. MSU led wire-to-wire and weathered a late run by the Griz. **Anthony Johnson** led UM with a season-high 31 points, but 14 of his points came in the last 1:34 of the game. **Johnson** got the Griz within four points (67-63) on a three-point shot with 51 seconds left, but the Cats then made 6-of-8 free throws to put the game out of reach. **Derek Selvig** was the only other Griz in double figures with 14 points. The Griz were out-rebounded 38-26.

EARLIER THIS SEASON: At **Montana 71, NAU 54:** In an early (Dec. 5) Big Sky opener for the teams, **Johnson** led UM with a game-high 22 points, and the Griz made 30-of-54 (55.6%) shots. The Jacks were led by *Shane Johanssen* with 16 points, and *Cameron Jones* had 12. UM led 34-31 at halftime. NAU out-rebounded UM 30-28.

Montana 84, at NAU 64: **Johnson** scored 28 and guard **Will Cherry** added a career-high 19 to lead the Grizzlies. The Griz shot 59.6% (31-of-52) from the field, including a 76.0% (19-of-25) in the second half. NAU made 24-of-55 (43.6%) shots. The Jacks were led by *Jones* with 22, and *DeAngelo Jones* added 14. MONTANA HEAD COACH WAYNE TINKLE (67-52, Fourth Season at UM)



Wayne Tinkle has an overall record of 67-52 (.563) and is 39-25 (.609) in the Big Sky. He is ranked eighth in school history with his 67 victories.

Tinkle, 41, was named the 26th head coach at Montana in the summer of 2006. He served as an assistant coach at UM for the previous five seasons, working with Krystkowiak for two seasons, two years with Pat Kennedy (2002-04), and one with Don Holst (2001-02).

In his inaugural season (2006-07) as head coach at his alma mater, Coach Tinkle guided Montana to a 17-15 overall record and a third-place finish in league with a 10-6 mark.

Tinkle was a standout forward for the Griz from 1985-89 and a three-time All-Big Sky pick his sophomore, junior and senior seasons.

He is ranked fourth in UM history in career rebounds with 836 and sixth in career points with 1,500. He is also ranked among the Big Sky's career leaders in both of those two categories.

He was Montana's *Carl Dragstedt Award* (MVP) winner in 1988 and 1989. He led the team in rebounding in 1987 (8.9 average), 1988 (8.4 average), and 1989 (8.7 avg.), and in scoring in 1988 (16.2 ppg) and 1989 (17.1 ppg).

He played in the professional ranks for 12 seasons, from 1990 to 2001. He played in the Continental Basketball League in Topeka, Kansas, and finished the year playing in Venezuela. In his professional career he played in the CBA and in Sweden, Spain, Italy and Greece. He played his final four seasons in Spain from 1995-99, where he ranked among the league's top scorers and rebounders.

Wayne was born in Milwaukee, Wis., and is the youngest of 11 children (seven girls and four boys). He is a 1984 graduate of Ferris High School in Spokane, Wash. He received his degree in health and human performance from UM in 2005.

He married former Lady Griz basketball star Lisa McLeod. Wayne and Lisa have three children: daughters Joslyn and Elleeson, and son Tres. Joslyn currently plays basketball at Stanford University.
